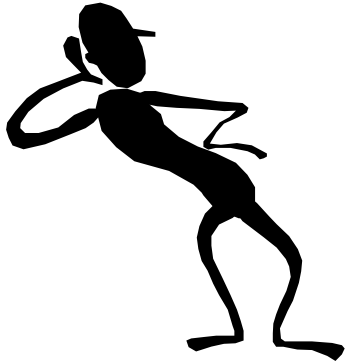

What We Do

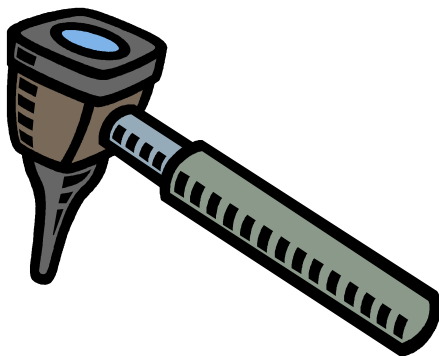
We provide refurbished hearing aids at a drastically reduced cost to seniors who need them, but cannot otherwise afford them.

What We Need

The Hearing Aid Bank is always accepting donations of used hearing aids. Any hearing aid can be used. Non functioning aids can be used for parts, while those in good condition can be fit on an individual in need. Custom devices can be remade to fit another person's ear.
